Chorlton Street Art Project – call for expressions of interest in painting a mural

Background

There is widespread interest in improving the appearance of the public realm in Chorlton, M21. The recent Chorlton Vision has pulled together repeated reports recommending public realm improvements and they can be found at

https://chorltonvision.co.uk/background. Chorlton Traders, in collaboration with Chorlton Voice (the Civic Society) and MCC neighbourhood officers, and with the support of Councillors in Chorlton and Chorlton Park Wards, have begun a Chorlton Street Arts project. This follows the highly successful painting of the mural on the Chorlton Metrolink and other murals that have been painted in the District. Extending the street art project is hugely important for residents in Chorlton, particularly in the light of recent upheavals and reduction in footfall due to the construction of the cycleway and the forthcoming redevelopment of the precinct.

Aim of the project

The initial stage of the Chorlton Street Art project is to paint some of the street cabinets/junction/exchange boxes that are in the street and attract unsightly tagging. They are the ones owned by phone companies in the main.

The aim is to create some street art, encouraging visitors to view Chorlton as a great destination and improving the area for residents. We are keen that the character of Chorlton is captured in all of the art, so are seeking proposals to paint boxes reflecting one of the following themes:

- 1. Nature: flowers, birds, wildlife; landscape scenes
- 2. Motivational images that inspire community and wellbeing
- 3. Well known Chorlton characters such as those from Cosgrove Hall studios

It is expected that any permissions for the use of images will have been obtained prior to commencement.

The steering group has agreed the following:

- The cabinet/junction box paintings will contribute to the vibrant identity of Chorlton as an artistic, creative, green, and vibrant place; lifting people's spirits; and strengthening a sense of community.
- In commissioning the work we will ensure, whilst respecting the artist's freedom of expression, that the street art works are striking pieces of artwork that will positively celebrate pride of place.

- The strategic positioning of the initial cabinet/junction box murals will make a vital first impression of Chorlton to visitors who have travelled to the district centre, helping to define it as a destination to visit not just to pass through.
- The junction box murals will greatly enhance the attractiveness district centre
- Each junction box mural should reflect one of the following themes:
 - 1. Nature: flowers, birds, wildlife; landscape scenes
 - 2. Motivational images that inspire community and wellbeing
 - 3. Well known Chorlton characters such as those from Cosgrove Hall studios

This call

The call is for expressions of interest in creating murals on prominently placed street cabinets/junction boxes in Chorlton district centre, many of which are currently heavily tagged.

Interested artists living or working in the South Manchester area are invited to complete a proposal as per the requirements below.

All proposals will be considered by the Steering Group who will then allocate junction boxes, based on the proposals submitted so as to create a good spread of images. At this stage we will discuss details about the images you have in mind and timescale.
